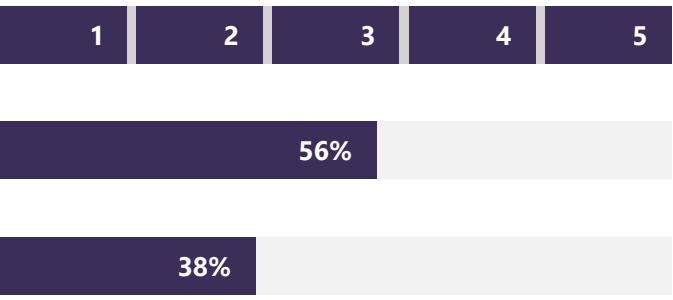

Office apps and services that you use every day—like Word, Excel, and PowerPoint—are built-in, giving you access to files and tools in one place, so you stay in your workflow.



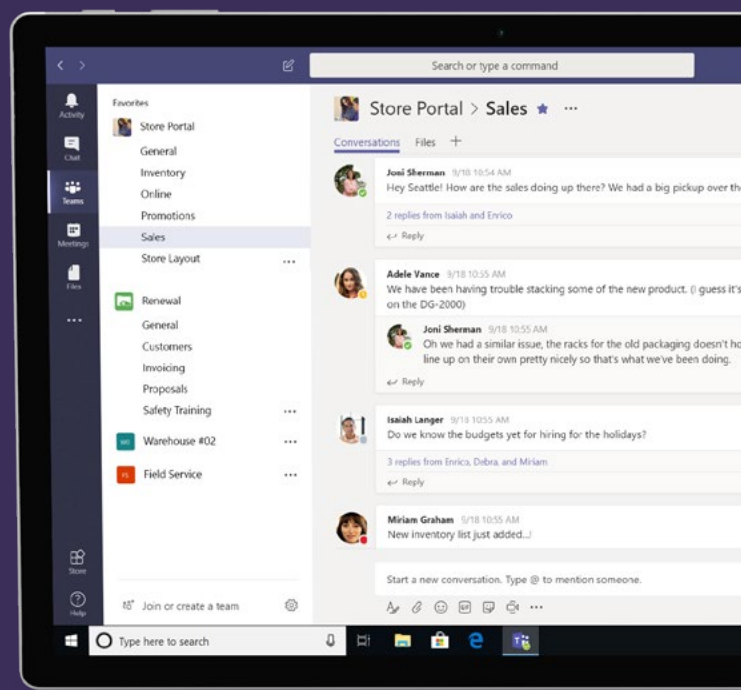
Chat privately one-on-one or have group conversations. Join meetings with HD audio and video, all in one place, instead of using multiple apps.
